During his campaign he pledged to have the most transparent administration in history. led the 38 organizations. They accused the Obama Administration of trying to stifle or block news coverage. They complained as access for reports has been cut off, the administration has opened the door to lobbyist, special interests and people with money.

Just a few weeks later 47 Inspector Generals, many of whom had been appointed by President Obama, sent a letter to the Government Reform Committee asking for their help. They complained the Obama Administration was withholding information from the Inspector Generals and preventing them from doing their jobs.

During his campaign, Obama promised to protect government whistle blowers. Google "Obama's war on whistleblowers" and see what pops up. Every major media outlet has reported on President Obama's unprecedented war on whistleblowers. His administration has gone after government employees and private citizens that have exposed fraud and corruption in government. The whistleblowers have been persecuted, harassed and severely punished while the perpetrators of the crimes they exposed go free. He has prosecuted more federal whistleblowers under the 1914 Espionage Act than all the President before him.

Even journalist weren't safe. New York Times journalist James Risen found that out the hard way. CBS correspondent Sharyl Attkisson was targeted by the White House and the Justice Department for her damming investigative story on the Fast and Furious scandal.

I have even felt the heat from the Obama Administration's campaign to silence me for exposing the rampant corruption and fraud in federal small business contracting programs.

While we're on that topic, what about President Obama's campaign promise, "It is time to end the diversion of federal small business contracts to corporate giants."

Every year of the Obama Administration, billions in federal contracts that by law should be going to middle class small businesses have been diverted to Fortune 500 firms and many of the largest corporate giants around the world. CNN, NBC, CBS and RTTV have all covered it. In May of 2015, Public Citizen released their investigative report, "Slighted: Accounting Tricks Create False Impression That Small Businesses Are Getting Their Share of Federal Procurement Money, and the Political Factors That Might Be at Play".

Every year the list of the top recipients of federal small business contracts is littered with the names of Fortune 500 firms, hundreds of "corporate giants" and big businesses. This is what I have come to expect from the man that told us last night, "Make the new economy work for everyone" and "Everybody that works hard should get a fair shot". I don't think small businesses having to compete with Fortune 500 firms for government small business contracts qualifies as "a fair shot".

The list goes on, and on, and on. PolitiFact has a great website that has kept track of Obama's very long list of broken promises to the American people. There is a great video in YouTube titled, "The Obama Record of Broken Promises." Even some of the Presidents biggest supporters in Hollywood like Matt Damon feel the same way I do.

Before Obama leaves office I would love to see some objective news commentator ask President Obama to respond to some of the many examples of the staggering chasm between his campaign promises and his State of the Union addresses and the realities of his Administration's policies.

President Obama has repeatedly urged the public to "hold him accountable". I will continue to do the best I can to comply with his request.


